## Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination (Qualified Persons) Fees (Amendment) Rules 2021

- Under the Exemption Order,
- Examination fees:
  - Any qualified person who wishes to take the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination shall pay a fee of three hundred and fifty ringgit [before amendment: one hundred and fifty ringgit] to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before he is allowed to take the said examination



**BAHASA MALAYSIA QUALIFYING EXAMINATION (QUALIFIED PERSONS) FEES RULES 1984\***


In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 6 of the Legal Profession Act 1976, the Qualifying Board makes the following Rules:

- 1. Citation and commencement.**  
These Rules may be cited as the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination (Qualified Persons) Fees Rules 1984 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th May 1984.
- 2. Examination fees.**  
Any qualified person who wishes to take the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination shall pay a fee of one hundred and fifty ringgit to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before he is allowed to take the said examination. [Am. PU (A) 2320/1]
- 3. Exemption fee.**  
Any qualified person who is exempted by the Qualifying Board from the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination shall pay a fee of one hundred ringgit to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before a certificate of exemption is issued to him. [Am. PU (A) 2320/1]
- 4. Certificate of Examination/Exemption.**  
The Certificate of Examination/Exemption shall be in the form as prescribed in the Schedule.

## Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination (Qualified Persons) Fees (Amendment) Rules 2021

- Under the Exemption Order,
- Exemption fee:
  - Any qualified person who is exempted by the Qualifying Board from the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination shall pay a fee of one hundred and fifty ringgit [before amendment: one hundred ringgit] to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before a certificate exemption is issued to him.

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 6 of the Legal Profession Act 1976, the Qualifying Board makes the following Rules:

- 1. Citation and commencement.**  
These Rules may be cited as the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination (Qualified Persons) Fees Rules 1984 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th May 1984.
- 2. Examination fees.**  
Any qualified person who wishes to take the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination shall pay a fee of one hundred and fifty ringgit to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before he is allowed to take the said examination. [Am. PU (A) 2320/1]
- 3. Exemption fee.**  
Any qualified person who is exempted by the Qualifying Board from the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Examination shall pay a fee of one hundred ringgit to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before a certificate of exemption is issued to him. [Am. PU (A) 2320/1]
- 4. Certificate of Examination/Exemption.**  
The Certificate of Examination/Exemption shall be in the form as prescribed in the Schedule.
