

PU (A) the Bahasa Malaysia Qualifying Bxamination shall pay a fee of one hundred 252001 ringgit to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before a certificate of exemption is issued to him. ringgit hundred and fifty [before amendment: one hundred and fifty ringgit] Certificate of Examination/Exemption. The Certificate of Examination/Exemption shall be in the form as prescribed in the Schedule. to the Secretary of the Qualifying Board before he is allowed to take the said examination
