




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What are the requirements to become a chartered accountant of MIA? 

- Anyone interested in becoming a Chartered Accountant at MIA must have one of the following qualifications recognised by the Institute:
 - a) Have passed any of the final examination specified in Part 1 of the First Schedule of the Accountants Act, 1967; or
 - b) Be a member of any of the recognised bodies specified in Part II of the First Schedule of the Accountants Act, 1967; or
 - c) Be eligible to sit for and has passed the Malaysian Institute of Accountants Qualifying Examination (QE).





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What are the requirements to become a chartered accountant of MIA?




- The MIA QE provides an alternative pathway for admission to become an MIA member for anybody who does not have a qualification recognised under Part 1 and Part II of the First Schedule to the Act.
- In addition, applicants in categories (a) and (b) above must have 3 years of practical experience in the service of a Chartered Accountant or in a government department, local authority or other commercial, financial, industrial or professional organisation or any other undertaking approved by the MIA Council.




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What are the requirements to become a chartered accountant of MIA?




- However, the [Institute's By-Laws](#) provides that all newly admitted members would be required to attend the Member Induction Course (e-MIC) which is conducted via e-learning within 6 months from the date of admission. Please note that there will be a fee to enroll for the e-MIC.
